


World Service Business Conference: Final Conference Report and More



Apply for Translation Funds by August 1



To help carry the message of hope and recovery worldwide, **OA makes funds** available to translate our literature anywhere there is a recognized need. Registered groups and service bodies and small groups of interested individuals who are working toward becoming a registered service body may apply for funds to help their translation efforts.

Applications are reviewed and funds awarded **three times per year**, and the next deadline is August 1.
